### **Program Notes**

*Voices Rising United* is based on the story and words of Malala Yousafzai, the young Pakistani activist, advocate for women's rights and education, and the youngest person ever to be nominated for the Nobel Peace Prize. Michael Robert Patch, the conductor and artistic director of the Kansas City Women's Chorus, commissioned the piece in the fall of 2013. The text, adapted from Malala's own words, was written by Kansas author and poet Debra Seely. The music utilizes harmonies idiomatic to pop music, as well as vocal sound effects and spoken elements. The Kansas City Women's Chorus premiered the piece on May 31, 2014, at the Folly Theater in Kansas City, Missouri.

### **Performance Notes**

The singers of the three musical solos (in measures 18-19, 54-57, and 118-120) should remain in the ensemble during the solos, and should not come to the front of the stage or be amplified apart from the ensemble in any way.

The same should apply to the whispering soloists (in measures 11-18 and 82-84). If there is concern about the whispered solos being heard (taking into account the size of the ensemble and the performance space), two alternative techniques may be used. First, more singers may be added to each part to increase the volume; however, care should be taken that the overall volume of the whispers be soft enough to be almost covered by the piano and choir.

Second, a technique similar to the spoken elements in measures 97 and following may be employed, in which one soloist whispers the word in rhythm as notated, and other members of the same section whisper the word ad lib for a measure or two, finishing before or slightly overlapping with the next whispered text. If this second technique is used, all of the whispering soloists should whisper the unison text in rhythm as notated at the end of the phrase (measures 18 and 84).
